US Ethanol, LLC Places Longview Ethanol Project on Temporary Hold

VANCOUVER, WASHINGTON, USA – As a result of the economic downturn, status of corn-based ethanol in general, international credit crunch and certain geo-political factors concerning food versus fuel issues, US Ethanol, LLC (“USE”) announced that it has temporarily halted development of its previously announced 55 million gallon per year corn-based ethanol plant in Longview, Washington. Once general economic and other conditions improve, USE intends to reevaluate the situation and determine whether or not to restart development of an ethanol facility. If development is restarted, it is likely that the ethanol facility will be cellulose – based rather than corn-based. In the meantime, USE will continue its ethanol distribution and retail sales of ethanol under its proprietary trademark, “US ETHANOL®.”
